A group of young street artists struggle to find a coach.

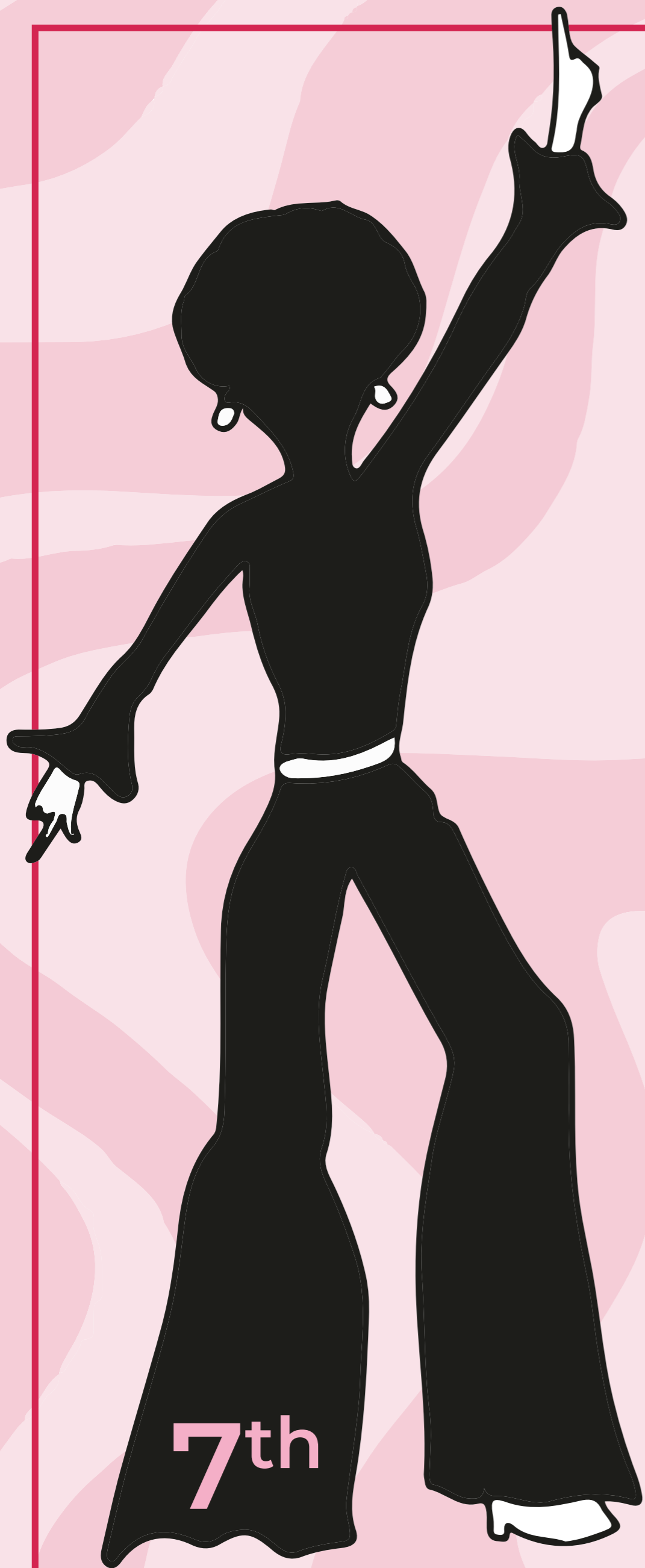
Everything gets better when Madonna gets involved, but they haven't realized she will try to change who they are.
